### BRIEF COURSE DESCRIPTION

This hands-on class is intended as a foundational class for technicians new to setting teeth. Participants will set a class 1 complete upper and lower denture in balanced occlusion using Enigma teeth. Lingualized occlusion will also be demonstrated. All materials and models will be provided but the participant is responsible for safety clothing and personal laboratory tools.

By the end of the class participants should be able to:

- Have an understanding of complete denture occlusion.
- Know how to access articulated models and set teeth to a balanced occlusion.
- Choose and set teeth to look natural.
- Use an Alma Gauge to fabricate a dimensionally accurate wax rim.
